COMING UP: IN-PERSON JUDGING, SELECTION 2025

Each year, SASA invites its members to submit up to three artworks for selection. Three judges, each highly esteemed within the art community, are appointed by our President to evaluate and score each submission individually and anonymously. This year marks the first time that the initial phase of our selection process will be conducted online.

PURPOSE OF THE SELECTION PROCESS

Progression Toward Fellowship

Fellowship is awarded to recognize a member's sustained dedication and excellence in artistic practice. To qualify for Fellowship, a member must achieve an overall score of 75% or higher in three out of four consecutive selections. After attaining Fellowship, members may work toward Senior Fellow and ultimately Master Fellow status using the same criteria.

Eligibility for the Annual Exhibition

Artworks that meet or exceed a specified score during selection become eligible for our prestigious Annual Exhibition. The threshold is determined by Council and is based on the capacity of the venue, the Richard Crowie Hall at Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens.

Eligibility for the Merit Exhibition

The top 40 artists with the highest overall scores during selection will be invited to present 5 new works for the Merit Exhibition, also held at the Richard Crowie Hall, the following year.

Next Steps

Members whose submission achieved a score of 19 or more will be invited to bring their artwork/s for in-person judging at the Athenaeum on Saturday 16 August 2025. (This qualifying score differs from the cut-off for the Annual Exhibition. All works that reach or exceed the Annual Exhibition score of 16 will be included in the exhibition.) It is from in-person judging that the judges confer and award Best Artwork in each of the 8 mediums will be selected, along with any works deemed by them to be awarded a Commended or Highly Commended.

We will confirm the date of the forthcoming Annual Exhibition via email once it has been advised by Kirstenbosch. Please monitor your inbox for further updates.




