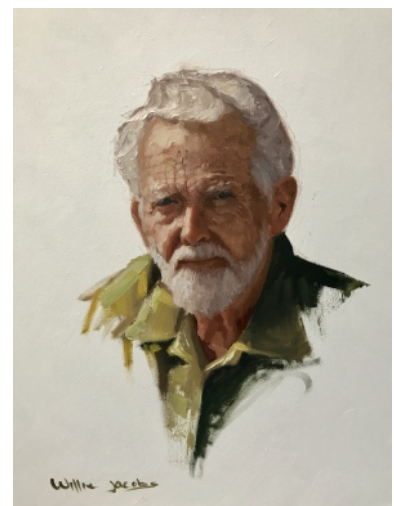

After the voting, tea, snacks and lot of chit chat with other members before going back to the hall for the awarding of the top honours.

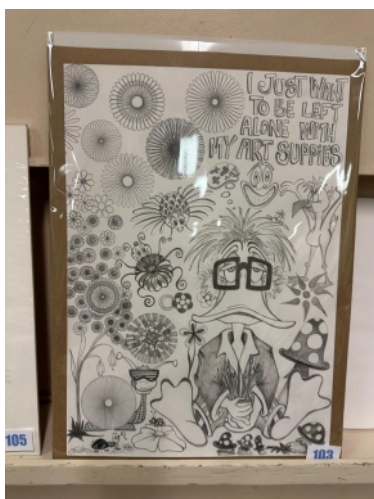
